 - c. Two reference letters from individuals familiar with the applicant and his/her involvement in the park and recreation field and indicating support for the applicants leadership, scholarship need, and potential for success in the field of parks and

recreation; and

- 4. The application must be completed in its entirety and received between July 1 and October 1. Failure to complete the entire application and provide all required information may result in disqualification of consideration.
