The following resources are useful for faculty when incorporating the important issues related to family recreation into professional recreation education courses:

Focus on the Family, is a Christian organization located in Colorado Springs, Colorado. It was founded by psychologist and author Dr. James Dobson; and publishes a number of materials that are of use to families. They have created approximately 200 first quality radio adventures for family listening. These stories are great for reliving the radio era with themes that have have current content. The series entitled, "Adventures in Odyssey" have many lessons including dating, respect for parents, camp experiences, and anger. There are also tapes that deal with historical events such as Thanksgiving, the Civil War, and the Vietnam War. Most of the stories have a Christian message, but some tapes have been created for use in secular situations and in the public schools. They are aired over radio stations throughout the country and tapes are available for purchase directly from Focus on the Family. These tapes are "Disney quality" and enjoyed by young and old alike.

The dramas are written for children between the ages of 8 to 12 and are great for stimulating family discussions and interaction. A fire in the fire place, a fresh popped bowl of popcorn and one of these very well written and produced episodes in the boom box make for a great evening of family fun. I am sure that Grandparents will have a few stories of their own to share at this family gathering.

Focus on the Family has produced books and video tapes using the same characters and ideals. Focus on the Family also distributes a paperback book entitled, *Finding Dollars for Family Fun: Creating happy memories on a budget* by Gwen Weising. This information is useful for families on a very tight budget. I have found this text useful in helping students understand the dynamics of family budgeting for recreation. Focus on the Family, as an organization, is an excellent source for demographic and topical information about contemporary youth and families.

The dazzling photographs are crystal clear and display complete with compact disc sound. This multimedia display makes for an entertaining and useful motivation tool for family outdoor adventure.
